Before assembly, remove all parts and part packages from box. If anything is missing, please contact the retailer from which the product was purchased.


- 1. Carefully pull house wires out of junction box so they are easily accessible during installation.
- 2. Position mounting bracket (A) so threaded ends of attached fixture mounting screws (E) are facing down towards floor.
- 3. Carefully pull house wires through center hole in mounting bracket (A).
- 4. Align small holes in mounting bracket (A) with holes in junction box.
- 5. Thread each junction box screw (B) into appropriate holes in mounting bracket (A) and into holes in junction box. Tighten junction box screws (B) to secure mounting bracket (A) to junction box.


CAUTION: Make sure house wires are pulled completely through hole in mounting bracket. **DO NOT** pinch wires between mounting bracket and ceiling.

- 6. Push fixture wires up through bottom of center stem (M). Pull fixture wires out of top of canopy (D). Pull fixture wires taut. Screw bottom of center stem (M) onto coupling on top of socket cluster (O).
- Screw recommended bulbs (E26 Edison bulb type, not included) into sockets. Verify correct bulb wattage marked on socket of fixture. WARNING: DO NOT exceed maximum bulb wattage.
- 8. Hold threaded pipe (G) so hexnuts are towards the top. Screw top of threaded pipe (G) into coupling on bottom of socket cluster (O).
- 9. Carefully raise glass shade (K) up to fixture. Pass hole in center of glass shade (K) over end of threaded pipe.
- 10. Slip washer (F) over end of threaded pipe (G) protruding from bottom of glass shade (K). Thread henxut (H) onto threaded pipe protruding from bottom of glass shade (K). Tighten hexnut (H) to secure glass shade (K) in place. DO NOT over tighten.
- 11. Slip bottom trim (L) over end of threaded pipe (G) protruding from bottom of glass shade (K). Thread finial (N) onto end of threaded pipe (G). Tighten finial (N) to secure bottom trim (L) in place. DO NOT over tighten.



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


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- 12. Hold arm (P) so end of arm with hook is at the top. Slip hook on top of arm (P) through one loop on top of center stem (M). Repeat this step for remaining arms (P).
- 13. Fit outer shade (R) over glass shade (K) Pass bottom of each arm through loops on inside of outer shade (R).
- 14. From inside outer shade (R), screw one threaded cap (S) onto end of each arm (P). Tighten threaded caps (S) to secure outer shade (R) in place. DO NOT over tighten.




- 15. Strip 3/4" of insulation from ends of fixture wires.
- 16. Slightly loosen ground screw on mounting bracket (A). Do not completely remove ground screw. Wrap house ground wire (copper) around ground screw, leaving enough ground wire to attach to fixture ground wire. Twist end of fixture ground wire and end of house ground wire (copper) together. Twist wire connector (C) onto ends of wires. Completely tighten wire connector (C). Reference chart below for correct wire connections.


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
- 17. Twist end of house lead wire (black) and end of fixture lead wire together. Twist wire connector (C) onto ends of wires. Completely tighten wire connector (C). Twist end of house neutral wire (white) and end of fixture neutral wire together. Twist wire connector (C) onto ends of wires. Completely tighten wire connector (C). Reference chart to the right for correct wire connections.
- 18. Wrap electrical tape (not included) around wire connectors (C) and wires. Ensure wires are securely fastened into wire connectors.
- 19. Carefully push all wires and wire connectors into junction box.

- 20. Carefully raise fixture up to ceiling. Place canopy (D) over mounting bracket (A). Pass holes in canopy (D) over ends of fixture mounting screws (E).
- 21. Screw one threaded cap (F) onto end of each fixture mounting screw (E). Tighten threaded caps (F) to secure fixture to ceiling. DO NOT over tighten.



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
